



Medical Exemption Placeholder Document

Usage: To be used as an alternative to uploading proof of medical exemption documentation

By uploading this document to any form found on the ARL – Adult Rookie League (“ARL”) website at <https://www.rookiehockey.ca>, you are knowingly declaring yourself as medically exempt from COVID-19 Proof of Vaccination requirements¹ within the Province of Ontario (the “Province”), set to take effect as of September 22, 2021.

As of September 10, 2021, you acknowledge that only the following medical exemptions are recognized by the Province:

- You have allergy to an ingredient in the vaccine (as proven in writing by an allergist or immunologist)
- or*
- You have experienced inflammation of the heart or its membrane (myocarditis or pericarditis) after receiving your first dose of an mRNA vaccine.

You also understand that a doctor's note which validates either condition must be presented at the time of entry to any sports or recreation facility (such as those utilized by the ARL), as per the requirements set forth by the Province.

The statements above have been prepared by the ARL with the limited information provided by the Province up until this date. The ask for proof of medical exemption or vaccination is to ascertain if the registering player is eligible to enter facilities used by the ARL on a “best effort basis”. Vaccination requirements may change at any time and are not in control of the ARL.
